Towards climate neutrality in the buildings sector: 10 Recommendations

A. Gear the policy framework to climate neutrality

- 1. A balanced policy mix to ensure a socially equitable transition to sustainable heating systems
- 2. Increase CO₂ prices and reduce electricity prices
- 3. Intelligently align standards with climate neutrality
- B. Distribute costs in a fair and socially equitable manner
- **4.** Create support programme endowed with 12 billion euros annually
- 5. Solve landlord-tenant dilemma through inclusion of heating costs in rental payments

- C. Smart infrastructure planning and development
- Mandate municipal heat planning for all municipalities
- Expand local and district heating networks while encouraging transformation to green energy sources
- **8.** Protect heating customers from the cost of market ramp-up for hydrogen

- D. Reduce costs while increasing capacities
- Simplify rooftop PV regulations for prosumers and tenant collectives
- Encourage standardized renovation solutions while funding training programmes for skilled labour in order to reduce costs and increase renovation rates
