

Commission presents European Green Deal, committing to climate neutrality by 2050.

September 2020

Commission proposes EU target to reduce net emissions by at least 55% by 2030, and add it to the European Climate Law.

April 2021

Political agreement reached on European Climate Law by European Parliament and Member States.

June 2021

European Climate Law enters into force.

March 2020

Commission proposes European Climate Law to write 2050 climate neutrality target into binding legislation.

December 2020

European leaders endorse Commission's proposed target to reduce net emissions by at least 55% by 2030.

July 2021

Commission presents package of proposals to transform our economy, to reach our 2030 climate targets. EU Parliament and Member States to negotiate and adopt package of legislation on reaching our 2030 climate targets.
