

- based on the results of many studies & discussions




1. GREEN BOOK – structuring the debate

1. GREEN BOOK - first answers

- ✓ starting point: goal triangle / RE and climate goals
- ✓ consequences: security of supply not negotiable /
 flexibility is one answer
- ✓ implementation: no regret measures like
 - strengthening market price signals
 - European integration, expanding grids
 - capacity reserve




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
2. WHITE BOOK – overview

Electricity market 2.0

Fundamental decision in favour of a liberalised, European electricity market

- 1. Security of supply
- 2. Cost-efficiency
- 3. Innovation and sustainability

Implementation

- 1. Stronger market mechanisms
- 2. Flexible and efficient power supply
- 3. Additional security



2. WHITE BOOK – 20 measures (here: selection)

- ✓ guarantee free price formation
- ✓ strengthen obligations to uphold balancing group commitments
- ✓ open up balancing markets for new providers
- ✓ revise special grid charges to allow for more DSM.
- ✓ monitore security of supply
- ✓ introduce capacity reserve





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3. ELECTRICITY MARKET BILL - overview

Referentenentwurf des Bundesministeriums für Wirtschaft und Energie

Entwurf eines Gesetzes zur Weiterentwicklung des Strommarktes (Strommarktgesetz)

- ✓ primarily electricy-marketbased measures
- ✓ on the basis of White Book an political agreement of 1. Juli

3. ELECTRICITY MARKET BILL – 1. Juli 2015

- ✓ fundamental decision for electricity market 2.0
 - capacity reserve
 - from 2021 up to 2 GW new and flexible power plants for
 South Germany
- ✓ climate contribution electricity sector
 - 2.7 GW lignite in reserve; no-way-back after four years



3. ELECTRICITY MARKET BILL – two reserves

✓ introduce capacity and climate reserve

- main function: back-up for electricity market 2.0
- additional function: contribution to climate goal


✓ continue to develop grid reserve

 function: safeguard grids against particular load situations in the grid



3. ELECTRICITY MARKET BILL – capacity and climate reserve






3. ELECTRICITY MARKET BILL – grid reserve

use synergies between reserves:


- ✓ reserves will be dovetailed
